- 3 carrier to operate, for the purpose of picking up or delivering
- 4 mail, parcels, or packages, a vehicle bearing license plates issued
- 5 under Section 551.452 on all or part of a public highway that:
- 6 (1) is in the corporate boundaries of the
- 7 municipality; and
- 8 (2) has a speed limit of not more than 35 miles per
- 9 hour.
- 10 (b) In addition to the operation authorized by Sections
- 11 <u>551.453</u> and 551.454, a county commissioners court may allow a motor
- 12 carrier to operate, for the purpose of picking up or delivering
- 13 mail, parcels, or packages, a vehicle bearing license plates issued
- 14 under Section 551.452 on all or part of a public highway that:
- 15 (1) is located in the unincorporated area of the
- 16 county; and
- 17 (2) has a speed limit of not more than 35 miles per
- 18 hour.
- 19 Sec. 551.456. CROSSING CERTAIN ROADWAYS. A vehicle bearing
- 20 license plates issued under Section 551.452 may cross
- 21 intersections, including on or through a road or street that has a
- 22 speed limit of more than 35 miles per hour.
- Sec. 551.457. CONFLICTS. In the case of a conflict between
- 24 this subchapter and other law, including Chapters 502 and 663, this
- 25 subchapter controls.
- 26 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
