(b) A property owners' association may not assess a fine 15 16 against a property owner for a violation of an applicable restrictive covenant that requires the owner to plant or install 17 grass or turf or maintain green vegetation or turf or prohibits 18 19 discolored or brown vegetation or turf on the property: (1) during a period when the owner's property is 20 21 subject to a residential watering restriction under which discolored or brown vegetation or turf could reasonably result; and 22 23 (2) before the 60th day after the date a residential watering restriction described by Subdivision (1) is lifted. 24
